Booming jobs market for Manufacturing and Motoring but harder times for Banking and Engineering sectors

- The UK jobs market continues to grow with 7.7% more vacancies on offer in
 August than in the same month last year
- The sectors driving this annual growth include Motoring & Automotive (+28.9%)
 and Manufacturing (+20.2%)
- However, Banking (-23.3%) and Engineering (-5.8%) are among those hardest hit since shock Brexit result
 - Job creation in London beginning to show signs of weakening while the North
 East, Wales and Northern Ireland experienced high levels of annual growth
 - The Reed Job Index stands at 281 for August

Up-to-the-minute data from the UK's largest job site, reed.co.uk, reveals that the jobs market continued to grow in August, up 7.7% on the same time last year. Overall, the Reed Job Index stands at 281.

The figures show that two thirds of the nation's employment sectors (70%) are healthier than they were in August 2015. The strongest amongst these are Security & Safety, Motoring & Automotive, and Manufacturing which experienced +40.3%, +28.9% and +20.2% annual growth respectively.

Banking, Scientific and Engineering are among the sectors hardest hit since the shock Brexit result with falls of -23.3%, -11.2% and -5.8% respectively.

Around the UK, every region continues to enjoy annual jobs growth, with Northern Ireland, Wales and the North East of England seeing the biggest increase in new opportunities (58.0%, 13.9% and 13.6% year on year growth respectively).



Monthly, the biggest slowdown occurred in London, with the capital seeing 5.8% fewer opportunities available in August compared with July and now at its lowest level since January 2016.

James Reed, Chairman of reed.co.uk comments:

"Despite July and August being seasonally quieter for recruitment, the UK's job market has continued to grow at a steady pace over the summer. Two thirds of the sectors analysed are up; the biggest gains are in Security & Safety, Motoring & Automotive, Education and Manufacturing.

Pleasingly, Apprenticeships have picked up strongly in August, and the Retail sector is performing better too.

The biggest falls have been seen in the Banking, Scientific and Engineering sectors. This has been felt most in London which has witnessed the largest month on month fall in the index, down 5.8% and now at its lowest level since January. The North East, Wales and Northern Ireland are all showing encouraging levels of growth.

At the moment, it's more of the same. But when the market changes, we'll be the first to see it because people advertise jobs on reed.co.uk long before they appear in government statistics."
